Consider This...

How You Can Promote FLG's Newly Adopted Slogan – "Preserve & Protect Lake Glenville"

FLG members committed over three years ago to actively fight any compromise of the lake, its amenities and adjacent private property rights by Duke Energy.

Now, many of our members have expressed additional areas of concern as the number of boats, PWC and other recreational users of the lake are increasing.

Here are some tips for insuring the safety, enjoyment and beauty of the lake for all those on the lake.

- Boats and PWCs should have enough life jackets on board for all passengers.
- Boating at high speeds in the coves cause shoreline erosion, damage docked boats and endanger swimmers and other boats in the area. Minimum wake is the rule in coves.
- There are no dumping stations on Lake Glenville, therefore boats with heads and galleys are prohibited.
- The boat "captain" is the driver *not* the drinker.
- Excessive noise from on board sound systems and loud speakers infringe on the personal space and enjoyment of other boaters and your neighbors.
- Remove trash and leftover food from an afternoon on the lake to your home trashcan or the dump.
- Construction sites without silt fences, uncontrolled storm water runoff from golf courses, roads and homes cause unwanted sediment to flow into the lake. Report these conditions, to Robbie Shelton, Jackson County Erosion Control Officer at 828-631-2261.
- Personal watercraft operators between the ages of 12 and 16 must complete a NASBLA approved boating education course, carry a certification card and proof of age. See NC Wildlife, www.ncwildlife.org.
